## Question - 1:

How do you stay organized?

#### Ane:

By maintaining proper routine every day. Putting my strongest points with my weakness. High priority always comes first As Senior Assistant.

## Question - 2:

How do you think you might fit this position As Senior Assistant?

#### Ane.

An important part of research before the interview is what the company does and how the job role relates to that. This includes the company philosophy and working methods. Questions such as this seek to find out how a candidate will fit into the organisation As Senior Assistant. Answer positively; including practical examples of how you anticipate you would perform in the new role.

## Question - 3:

How would your boss and co-workers describe you?

## Ans:

First of all, be honest (remember, if you get this job, the hiring manager will be calling your former bosses and co-workers!). Then, try to pull out strengths and traits you haven't discussed in other aspects of the interview As Senior Assistant, such as your strong work ethic or your willingness to pitch in on other projects when needed.

## Question - 4:

Tell me about a time you failed?

## Ans:

Everyone has failed, so don't play dumb or claim you've never messed up As Senior Assistant. Think of a time when a work-related situation didn't turn out quite as you had hoped. An interviewer is interested in seeing how you took responsibility for your failure, what you learned from it, and how you would prevent similar failures from happening again.

Why are you leaving last job?

## Ans:

Although this would seem like a simple question, it can easily become tricky. You shouldn't mention salary being a factor at this point As Senior Assistant. If you're currently employed, your response can focus on developing and expanding your career and even yourself. If you're current employer is downsizing, remain positive and brief. If you employer fired you, prepare a solid reason. Under no circumstance should you discuss any drama or negativity, always remain positive.

How did you handle meeting a tight deadline As Senior Assistant?

## Ans:

Review every deadline you need to meet. Prioritize your projects by deadline and factor in how important each project is. Record your deadlines on a digital calendar or spreadsheet.

At first place, you try to avoid conflicts if you can. But once it happens and there's no way to avoid it, you try to understand the point of view of the other person and find the solution good for everyone. But you always keep the authority of your position.

#### Question - 9:

What do you consider to be your weaknesses?

#### Ans:

What your interviewer is really trying to do with this question-beyond identifying any major red flags-is to gauge your self-awareness and honesty. So, "I can't meet a deadline to save my life As Senior Assistant" is not an option-but neither is "Nothing! I'm perfect!" Strike a balance by thinking of something that you struggle with but that you're working to improve. For example, maybe you've never been strong at public speaking, but you've recently volunteered to run meetings to help you be more comfortable when addressing a crowd.

#### Question - 10:

Describe a typical work week for this position As Senior Assistant?

#### Ans:

Interviewers expect a candidate for employment to discuss what they do while they are working in detail. Before you answer, consider the position As Senior Assistant you are applying for and how your current or past positions relate to it. The more you can connect your past experience with the job opening, the more successful you will be at answering the questions.

Explain me about your experience working in this field As Senior Assistant?

Give me an example of an emergency situation that you faced. How did you handle it?

#### Question - 16:

What do you think is your greatest weakness?

#### Ane.

Don't say anything that could eliminate you from consideration for the job. For instance, "I'm slow in adapting to change" is not a wise answer, since change is par for the course in most work environments. Avoid calling attention to any weakness that's one of the critical qualities the hiring manager is looking for. And don't try the old "I'm a workaholic," or "I'm a perfectionist.

## Question - 17:

What schedule do you hope to work? Are you willing to work extra hours?

#### Ans:

Be honest. If you really want the job and are willing to work any schedule needed, say so. If, however, you have no intention of working late hours or weekends, simply let the interviewer know the hours that you are available to work. The same applies to extra hours. You are more likely to be hired if you are willing to work any time you are needed. However, saying that you are willing and then complaining about the hours once you start working is a recipe for disaster.

How do you evaluate your ability to handle conflict?

## Question - 19:

How do you keep each member of the team involved and motivated?

#### Ans:

Many managers mistakenly think that money is the prime motivator for their employees. However, according to surveys by several different companies, money is consistently ranked five or lower by most employees. So if money is not the best way to motivate your team, what is? Employees' three most important issues according to employees are:

- \* Respect
- \* A sense of accomplishment
- \* Recognition

## Question - 20:

What was the most important task you ever had?

## Ans:

There are two common answers to this question that do little to impress recruiters:

- \* 'I got a 2.1
- \* 'I passed my driving test'

No matter how proud you are of these achievements, they don't say anything exciting about you. When you're going for a graduate job, having a degree is hardly going to make you stand out from the crowd and neither is having a driving licence, which is a requirement of many jobs.

## Question - 21:

Do you know anyone that works with our company?

## Ans:

Sometimes companies have policies relating to the hiring of individuals related to current company employees. If you are related to anyone working for the company make sure you're aware of company policies before you enter the interview. If you have a friend or acquaintance working for the company make sure have good relationship with this individual before mentioning them.

## Question - 22:

Did you consider yourself a team player?

## Ans:

Of course you're a team player - who isn't. But a simple yes probably isn't the response the interviewer is looking for. Be ready to provide specific example of how you've worked as part of a cohesive team to get things accomplished and how you've focus on team performance rather than individual performance. Make sure not to brag as this will make it appear as that you're more concerned about your own performance and accomplishments than those of the team.

## Question - 23:

Are you willing to work overtime or odd hours?

## Ans

Be completely honest. You don't want to lie to get the job if you're not going to work the hours required.

#### Question - 24:

What have you learned from mistakes on the job?

#### Ans:

Candidates without specific examples often do not seem credible. However, the example shared should be fairly inconsequential, unintentional, and a learned lesson should be gleaned from it. Moving ahead without group assistance while assigned to a group project meant to be collaborative is a good example.

Tell me about the most fun you have had on the job?

## Ans:

When answering this question, discuss situations where you completed tasks benefitting your previous employers.

## Question - 26:

Where do you see yourself in five years? Ten years?

#### Anc.

Bad Answer: A generic or uninspired answer. Also, answers that show that this career/company is just a temporary stop for them.

Good answer: One that shows the candidate has thought about this question, has plans, and that those plans align with the job and a career path that is possible in the company. You want to see that this candidate is a good long term investment.

#### Question - 27:

Tell me about a time when you had to use your presentation skills to influence someone's opinion As Senior Assistant?

#### Ane.

Example stories could be a class project, an internal meeting presentation, or a customer facing presentation.

## Question - 28:

Describe a time when you put your needs aside to help a co-worker understand a task. How did you assist them? What was the result?

## Ans:

The key is to show that the mentoring of a co-worker was first a higher priority than the task you had at hand (remember, you want to show that you focus on highest priority tasks first). Then, describe in detail how you helped them not only complete the task but learn to do it on their own. You want to teach them HOW to fish and not to simply fish for them.

## Question - 29:

What are you passionate about?

## Ans:

Ask yourself - what are your core passions that you wake up excited to act on each and every day? Ask yourself what makes you happy or drives you - is it helping others? Is it making money? Is it creating something? Is it about changing the world? Etc.

How have you achieved your success?

## Ans:

Discuss stories of how you've progressed over the years to achieve success. People relate best to stories.

Describe yourself in three words?

## Ans:

Pick three adjectives but then back up each with a real life story that demonstrates those characteristics.

## Question - 32:

What do you feel you deserve to be paid?

## Δns.

Do your research before answering this question - first, consider what the market average is for this job. You can find that by searching on Google (title followed by salary) and globalguideline.com and other websites. Then, consider this - based on your work experience and previous results, are you above average, if yes, by what % increase from your pay today from your perspective? Also - make sure if you aim high you can back it up with facts and your previous results so that you can make



a strong case.

## Question - 33:

How have you shown yourself to be a leader?

#### Δns·

Think about a time where you've rallied a group of people around a cause / idea / initiative and successfully implemented it. It could be a small or large project but the key is you want to demonstrate how you were able to lead others to work for a common cause.

### Question - 34:

What classes did you enjoy most in college and why?

#### Anc.

Think back to the classes that either resonated with your passion or truly helped you to develop skills that you believe will help you in your career. Talk about those.

What types of books or magazines do you typically read?

#### Ans:

Describe both your personal and professional favorites. If you happen to like professional books / magazines that relate to the industry of the company you're applying for - that's definitely worth highlighting.

#### Question - 36:

Do you have the ability to articulate a vision and to get others involved to carry it out?

#### Ans:

If yes, then share an example of how you've done so at work or college. If not, then discuss how you would do so. Example: "I would first understand the goals of the staff members and then I would align those to the goals of the project / company. Then I would articulate the vision of that alignment and ask them to participate. From there, we would delegate tasks among the team and then follow up on a date and time to ensure follow through on the tasks. Lastly, we would review the results together."

## Question - 37:

How articulate are you in expressing your ideas?

## Ans

One of the best ways to answer this question is clearly articulate three points that demonstrate how articulate you are (and in a sense show that in a live setting) - for example: "I would say I'm articulate because one, I typically gather my thoughts before speaking, two, I organize my thoughts well, and three I'm concise when making a point.

## Question - 38:

Would you describe yourself as more analytical or interpersonal?

## Ans:

If you answer either, just make sure you explain why. For example, "I would consider myself to be more analytical because I'm good at examining a data set and then understanding how to interpret it in a business environment." or "I'm more of interpersonal person because I enjoy working and collaborating with my teammates and clients"

## Question - 39:

How would you define success?

## Ans:

Success is defined differently for everybody. Just make sure the parameters are defined by you with regards to work life balance, financial gain, career growth, achievements, creating meaningful work / products and so forth. If you can clearly articulate what it means to you that is a strong answer.

How do you act when you encounter competition?

## Ans:

This question is designed to see if you can rise the occasion. You want to discuss how you are the type to battle competition strongly and then you need to cite an example if possible of your past work experience where you were able to do so.

What would you like to have accomplished by the end of your career?

#### Ans:

Think of 3 major achievements that you'd like to accomplish in your job when all is said and done - and think BIG. You want to show you expect to be a major contributor at the company. It could be creating a revolutionary new product, it could be implementing a new effective way of marketing, etc.

## Question - 42:

What's the least rewarding work you've ever done and why?

#### Ans:

Describe work you've done that you feel doesn't take advantage of your full potential. For example, "I once had to make paper copies for my job and I feel it didn't take full advantage of my skills. However, it did teach me to be humble in my work and to appreciate a good opportunity when it arose to use my skills"

### Question - 43:

What other jobs are you applying for As Senior Assistant?

#### Ans:

If you're applying with other similar companies in a similar or the same industry, it's actually okay to state that as it shows you're valued and wanted.

Why should we give you this job As Senior Assistant when someone else is equally qualified?

#### Δns·

Describe how you're unique, but make sure you tie it to the job responsibilities and how you would impact the company. For example, "I believe my unique programming skills and experience in developing over 18 best selling iphone apps will help the company develop high quality applications faster than my competitors"

## Question - 45:

If I talked to your three biggest fans, who would they be and why?

#### Ans:

If you can reference three professionals with executive titles (CXO, VP, Director, Manager), that carries a lot of weight. Make sure you highlight how you've helped them achieve their biggest objectives and how that's made them your fan.

## Question - 46:

Describe a time when you've been overwhelmed with work?

## Ans:

Show how you were able to over the "overwhelmed" feeling - by delegating tasks, getting people on your team to help you out, or by prioritizing your work and focusing on the most important issues first As Senior Assistant.

Describe what a "lot of work" looks like to you As Senior Assistant?

## Ans:

Ideally you'd like to state that you can take on a lot of work - this shows your work ethic, but at the same time it's okay to tell them that you value work and life balance.

## Ans

Describe the attributes you liked about your favorite manager, typically attributes discussed are: Great at coaching, inspiring, motivating, empowering, trusting, delegating, leading, etc.

Do not belittle or talk badly of your last boss - it will come off as being petty. Instead, talk about the positive lessons you were able to learn from your last boss.

List three attributes that you aspire to attain / build in the next few years - and then explain how you would develop those.

### Question - 51:

What are the qualities of a good leader As Senior Assistant? A bad leader?

A good leader provides constructive criticism, motivates and inspires, coaches the mentee to be successful with their set of skills, and encourages them to push themselves. A bad leader only cares about his/her own interests and does not look out for the success of his/her staff.

## Question - 52:

There's no right or wrong answer, but if you could be anywhere in the world right now, where would you be?

#### Ans:

Just be honest about where you'd like to be - you never know - you may end up bonding with the interviewer with the location. However, you want to stress that you want to work out of the location that you're interviewing for.

What do you do in your spare time?

#### Δns·

If you want to show your fun side, discuss your extracurricular activities. If you want to show your ambition, discuss the work / school projects you do in your spare time.

#### Ans:

It should say the same thing - after all - if you think this salary is fair then it should suit the responsibilities!

#### Anc.

Discuss your work experiences. The key is to show you're calm under pressure and can handle sensitive situations with a clear train of thought.

#### Anc.
