Question - 1:

Explain what is export declaration?

Ans:

Export declaration is a government document that defines the goods to be supplied out of the country. This declaration should be filed by exporter to the U.S government.

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Question - 2:

What is TEU?

Ans:

TEU stands for Twenty foot Equivalent Unit. It is a method of calculating vessel load or capacity, in units of containers that are twenty feet long. For example, a 40ft long container measure 2TEUs.

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Question - 3:

What is cross docking?

Ans:

Cross docking is a process of unloading materials from an incoming semi-truck and loading directly into out-bounds trucks or trailers. It reduces handling costs, operating costs and the storage of inventory.

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Question - 4:

What is blanket way bill?

Ans:

A way bill which covers two or more consignment of freight is referred as blanket way bill.

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Question - 5:

How do you motivate staff?

Ans:

Motivation is a key management requirement, and your answer should stress strong values like positive reinforcement for performance, training in higher duties, and other incentives.

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Question - 6:

What is your training as event coordinator?

Ans:

Training may include higher education and/or on-the-job training from past jobs. BA's in public relations, hospitality services, marketing, business communication, etc. are highly valued, especially by business companies.

Explain what is declared the value for carriage?

**Ans:**

Declared value for carriage is the value of the goods, declared by the shipper on the bill of lading, to determine the limit of the carrier's liability or a freight rate.

Question - 8:

What is affreightment?

Ans:

Affreightment is a contract between ship owner and merchant, where ship owner provides or rented the space in the ship to the merchant for an agreed amount and for a specific period. In this contract, merchant is liable for the payment whether or not the ship is ready for the shipment.

Freight class is based on four factors

- Density: Weight per cubic foot
- Freight Stowability: width and length based on carrier mode rules
- Ease of handling: Evaluation of the effort required in transporting

The only lawful bases for dismissal are well defined into types:

- * Misconduct
- * Performance
- * Theft or fraud (A real problem in supply chains)
- * Drug or alcohol abuse

Explain what is documents against acceptance?

Ans:

A documents against acceptance are an arrangement or provision, where exporter instructs a bank to hand over shipping and title documents to the importer only if the importer agrees the accompanying bill of exchange or draft by signing it. This provision ensures that the buyer is legally bound to pay the full price to the exporter for the shipments, before ownership is transferred.

Ans:

Anti-dumping duty is an import duty levied in cases where imported goods are priced at less than the normal price in the exporter's domestic market and cause material loss to the domestic industry of the importing country.

Ans:

Supply chain management includes an integrated approach of planning, implementing and controlling the flow of information, materials and service from raw material to the finished good for the ultimate distribution to the customer.

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Question - 17:

This position requires familiarity with a fully automated warehouse, including an integrated accounts database. Can you tell us about your experience working with these systems?

Ans:

This question requires a full answer detailing particular systems you've worked with in the past. The interviewers evaluate this experience in relation to the job requirements.

How do you promote Occupational Health and Safety in the workplace?

Ans:

OHS is critically important in all areas of supply chain work. You need to cite a working example of full OHS awareness programs, including training where required.

What are some of the important characteristics of an efficient event coordinator?

Ans:

To organize events, a coordinator must be organized, have no time management problems, and be detail oriented. In addition, communication must be on a high level, since events require cooperation and rapport with many different types of people.

What is ASN (Advance Shipping Notice)?

Ans:

It is a notice that is sent to the customer about the detailed shipment information in advance of delivery. It may also include carrier and shipment related information like time of shipment and expected time of arrival.

- Document against payment: The document remains with bank and importers have to pay the exporter before they release the documents. In this payment is immediate, and document is released quickly
- Document against acceptance: In this importer gives 30-45 days to bank to deduct the amount and then release the documents. In this provision, there is much risk, and if there is no sufficient balance in the account then, the process will get delayed.

Ans:

Customer relationships are a key point in logistics manager jobs. This is also a problem solving question, requiring you to illustrate the situation, define the customer relationship issues, and how you solved the problem.

Ans:

Some forms of performance management encourage increased participation by staff, involving training programs, extra duties on a career track basis, and other incentives. Your answer needs to outline clear standards in this approach.

* Speak about specifics that relate to the position you are applying for. If you do not have specific experience, get as close as you can.

A bill of lading includes following details

- Name and complete address of shippers and receivers
- Special account numbers or PO used between business for order tracking
- Instruction for the carrier for secure delivery
- Date of the shipment
- Number of shipping units
- Types of packaging that includes cartons, pallets, skids and drums
- Description about the shipped items (common name & material of manufacture)
- Declared value of the goods being shipped
- Note included if there is any hazardous substance in it
- Exact weight of the shipments - for multiple commodities, weight for each commodity is mentioned separately
- Freight classification of the items shipped, according to NMFC (National Motor freight classification)

You should respond with an answer that shows progression in your career is on track with your route in the company. It's important to do your research on company prospects, this way you understand what to expect and if it's in your long-term goal. Interviewers don't want to set you on a path that won't provide the results you want, resulting in you resigning.

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Question - 63:

Do you have work experience as Logistics Coordinator?

Ans:
If you're a recent grad, this might be tough one, but not impossible. An internship provides you with the experience employers want, perhaps more importantly, you'll have an opportunity to network with other logisticians, perhaps securing a job after you graduate. It's important though to balance internships with work because generally work experience is more highly sought after.

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Question - 64:

What do you consider to be your best weakness as Logistics Coordinator?

Ans:
This can be a tricky question to respond to, if you suggest you have no weaknesses you're going to appear as a liar or egotistical. You should respond realistically by mentioning small work related weaknesses. Although many try to answer using a positive skill in disguise as a weakness, like "I expect co-workers to have the same commitment" or "I am a perfectionist". However, it is recommended that there is some honesty and the weaknesses are true, and then emphasize on how you have overcome it or working to improve it. The purpose of this question is to see how you view and evaluate yourself.

Ask about what systems do they have in place?

Ans:
Another question you could ask is about what kind of systems they have in place. If their present systems are inadequate, will it be your job to change or develop them? It's good to show the interviewer that you're proactive and have initiative, but you first have to determine if they're open to that. If you're someone who likes to implement change, you wouldn't want to work for an organisation that is change-averse and doesn't like to fix things that ain't broke.

What are your salary expectations as Logistics Coordinator?

Ans:
This question is like a loaded gun, tricky and dangerous if you're not sure what you are doing. It's not uncommon for people to end up talking salary before really selling their skills, but knowledge is power as this is a negotiation after all. Again, this is an area where doing your research will be helpful as you will have an understanding of average salary.
One approach is asking the interviewer about the salary range, but to avoid the question entirely, you can respond that money isn't a key factor and your goal is to advance in your career. However, if you have a minimum figure in mind and you believe you're able to get it, you may find it worth trying.

Although this would seem like a simple question, it can easily become tricky. You shouldn't mention salary being a factor at this point. If you're currently employed, your response can focus on developing and expanding your career and even yourself. If you're current employer is downsizing, remain positive and brief. If your employer fired you, prepare a solid reason. Under no circumstance should you discuss any drama or negativity, always remain positive.

* Speak about specifics that relate to the position you are applying for. If you do not have specific experience, get as close as you can.

* If you are being asked this question from your employer then you can explain your experience. Tell the employer what responsibilities you were performing during your job. You can tell what programs you developed and what modules you worked on. What were your achievements regarding different programs.

* I have been working with computers since 2001. I also have a degree in network support/computer repair. I have built my last 3 computers, have work with Dell as an employee. So I have around 15 years experience working with computers.

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Question - 69:

Do you have the five universal skills to be successful in a logistics-related position?

Ans:

When it comes to getting a job, it's important to be able to at least somewhat expect what types of questions will be thrown at you. Employers look for candidates with a variety of skills, but you can almost depend on them to be looking for those who possess the following traits:

- * People skills
- * Analytical skills
- * Communication skills
- * Computer skills
- * Flexibility

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Question - 70:

Tell me about your Logistics Coordinator skills?

This is a common question during an interview, possibly the most asked. It is used as an ice breaker, gets you talking about something comfortable, but you need to have something prepared for a response. However, you don't want it to sound memorized. You should work chronologically, starting as far back as possible and working until present.

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Question - 72:

Ask about your role, the company and their industry!

Ans:

After doing as much research as you can about the company and carefully reading the job description, ask specific questions about the organisation and your role there. What's their vision for your position? Will it change and evolve over time? What are the company's goals? Asking industry-specific questions is good too, especially if you've read something topical in the news or if recent government legislation has affected the industry. This will show the interviewer that you're keen, have done your homework and are a go-getter. They're sure to be impressed.

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
